

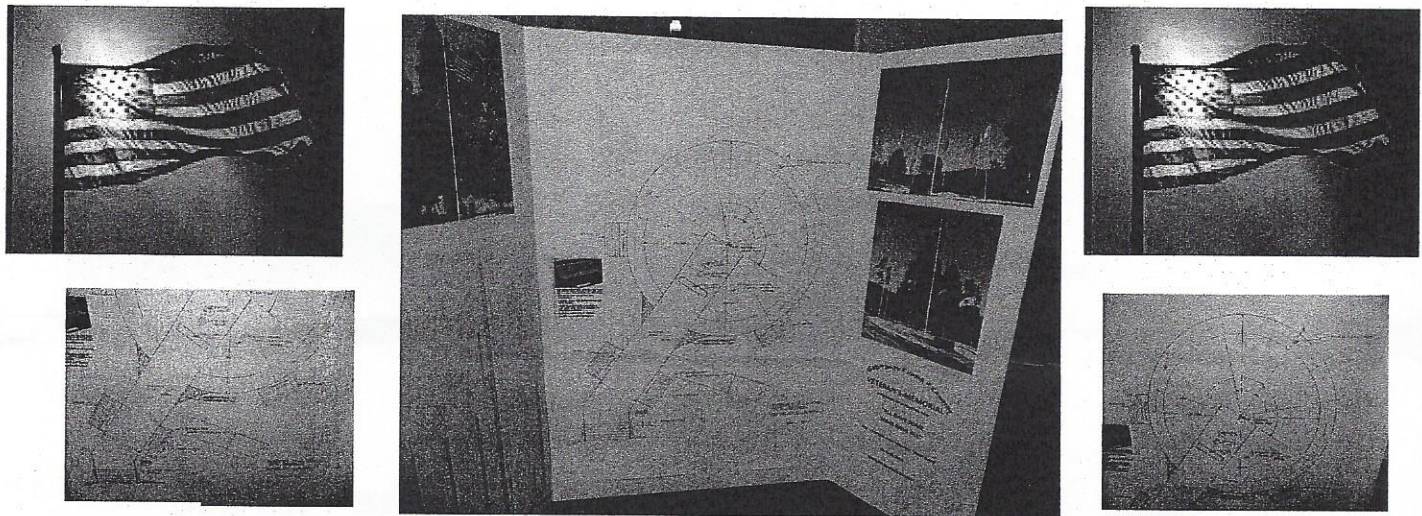
Madera County Veterans Memorial Ahwahnee, California

The Oakhurst Elks Lodge #2724 along with several local service groups are currently constructing a Veterans Memorial in Ahwahnee, which is near Oakhurst.

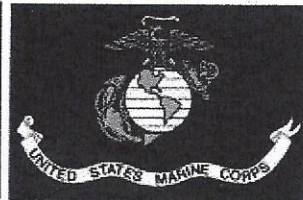
We encourage and invite you to come to the opening ceremony beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Flag Day 14 June 2017.

The Ceremony will involve raising the US Flag and flags of all five branches of the military by their respective members, with the playing of taps in the background.

Among those attending, will be County officials, local service groups, Eagle Scouts, First Responders and Contributors to the monument, including the VFW, Marine Corp League, E Clampus Vitus, Sierra Tel, Sierra Ambulance, and the Oakhurst Elks Lodge along with a few others.

The Oakhurst Elk's part of the project is to provide a granite monument which will show a battlefield cross, (Boots, Rifle and Helmet), on the front and "We will never forget our Veterans" Oakhurst Elks Lodge #2724 on the back. It is the result of a \$2,000 Gratitude Grant from the Elks National Foundation (ENF).

The Elks mandate celebrating Flag Day every year on 14 June. What better way to celebrate Flag Day than to witness and honor our military veterans at the New Veterans Memorial in our own District.

Directions: From the intersection of Hwy-41 & Hwy-49 in Oakhurst. Turn west on Hwy-49 and travel about 6.0 miles. Just past the fire station and Wasuma Elementary School you will see the entrance sign on the right which says, "Ahwahnee Hills Regional Park". The address is 43469 Hwy-49, Ahwahnee, California.
